Captain William G. Chandler was part of the Military Advisor Command Vietnam (MACV) Advisor Team 88 to advise units of the South Vietnamese army to confront the North Vietnam Army (NVA) in a contested area of South Vietnam. The following is a brief account of what took place on August 11, 1972. "In August 1972...CPT Bill Chandler, the province S-2 advisor, was sent out...and immediately killed in an ambush just west of the Tre Bong Bridge."

Captain Chandler had served a previous tour of duty in Vietnam with the 9<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division. His name is on the Vietnam Memorial wall in Washington, D.C. Panel 01W, Line 62. He is buried at Willamette National Cemetery, Portland, Oregon.
